
POOL LINER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Be sure ground is level with no undergrowth and properly prepared.
- 2. Build an earth mound around the inner circumference of the pool wall.
- Place the liner in the center of pool and unfold. Be sure liner is centered in the pool otherwise there will be excess material on one end of the pool and insufficient material in the other end.
- 4. Make sure that the seam joining the floor and side wall is on the earth mound.
- If overlap, drape the side wall over the top of the pool; if beaded, "snap" wall into tracking.
- 6. Smooth out any remaining wrinkles by pushing them toward the pool wall with a soft broom. Never try to eliminate wrinkles by pulling excess material over the side of pool since this will damage your pool liner.
- 7. When completed, your liner must be supported in all points (see figure 1). Recall, that the liner is unable to support the weight of the water, which must be supported by the structural parts of the pool, the ground and the earth mound.

Jumping and Diving into an above ground pool is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. It is extremely dangerous to dive or jump into an above ground pool since serious injury or paralysis can result. It is your responsibility as the owner of the pool to do the following:

- Do not locate near objects that would entice diving i.e. garages, trees, porches, etc...
- Do not let anyone use your pool unless they are fully aware of the DO NOT DIVE OR JUMP notice.
- · Do not promote horse play or other activities that would cause injuries.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY AS A POOL OWNER NOT THE MANUFACTURER'S TO INSURE THE SAFETY OF WHOMEVER USES THE POOL.

CAUTION

AN ABOVE GROUND POOL IS DESIGNED FOR SWIMMING ONLY. IT IS NOT INTENDED FOR DIVING OR JUMPING.

FOR A MAXIMUM OF SWIMMING FUN, BE SURE TO FOLLOW ALL SAFETY RULES WHEN USING ANY SWIMMING POOL.

General Procedures, Cautions and Maintenance

- The pool liner is not a structural part of the pool. It is not designed to support the weight of water, rather its only function is to keep the water from leaking out of the pool. The water pressure is held by the pool wall and structural parts, not by the liner. Therefore, the liner must be installed properly with all areas touthing the ground, earth mound and pool wall and not supporting the weight of the water.
- 2. The pool liner must be installed on level ground with no undergrowth.
- 3. An earth mound (approximately 7" to 8" high and forming a diagonal against the inner pool wall) must be constructed, using suitable sand (obtained from your pool dealer) around the entire inner circumference of the pool where the pool comes into contact with the ground. The purpose of the earth mound is to support the liner at the critical point where the side wall of the liner is joined to the bottom part. It is therefore essential that the seam joining the side wall to the bottom rest on the earth mound, otherwise the seam will tear from the pressure of the water.
- 4. Slight wrinkles appearing during installation of the pool liner are natural and are caused by the fact that the pool sizes differ slightly and by slight over allowance of vinyl material to avoid damage to the liner if shrinkage should occur. Never try to eliminate wrinkles by pulling the excess material over the side of the pool, since this will cause damage to your liner. Rather, smooth out the floor of the liner by pushing wrinkles toward the pool wall with a soft broom. Never forcefully pull or drag the liner.
- Do not empty your pool. Your pool and liner should be left standing with water all year round (proper winterization using covers, pillows and chemicals can be obtained from your local pool dealer).

10 SEASON LIMITED POOL LINER WARRANTY

Please read installation instructions and warnings prior to installing pool liner.

- This pool liner is warranteed, at the time of original purchase, to be free from defects in material and workmanship. Your pool liner must be inspected carefully, prior to installation since the magnificular is not responsible for rips, tears or punctures due to mishandling or improper installation.
- 2. Pegasus agrees to repair or replace, at its option, any pool increment the seam comes apart due to manufacturing defect according to the following pro-rated schedule. Note that all warranty claims must be made directly with Pegasus and that no defective merchandise is to be returned to Pegasus without prior written authorization.
- Note that a puncture, rip or tear directly above or below the seam is the result of excess water pressure due to improper installation or vandalism. Such tears or rips are not seam separations and such damage is specifically not covered by this warranty.
- The following pro-rated replacement schedule constitutes a percentage of the current suggested manufacturer's retail price.

First Season	No charge	Sixth Season	70%
Second Season	30%	Seventh Season	80%
Third Season	40%	Eighth Season	80%
Fourth Season	50%	Ninth Season	90%
Fifth Season	60%	Tenth Season	90%

Exclusions and Claim Procedures:

- 1. A season ends on December 31st of each calendar year,
- Purchaser shall pay all freight charges to and from factory for any pool liner to be repaired or replaced. In addition, purchaser must provide

- the manufacturer with a sales slip confirming the date of purchase and a written statement describing the defect. It is the purchaser's obligation and responsibility to dry, clean and repack any liner returned to Pegasus.
- Purchaser is responsible for all installation or reinstallation costs for any pool liner repaired or replaced.
- Neither Pegasus or dealer shall under any conditions be responsible for the cost of any labor, water, chemicals, sand and/or any other incidental or consequential costs or damage.
- 5. The pool liner must be installed correctly according to the installation instructions. Neither Pegasus nor dealer is responsible for any damage caused by faulty installation, improper acts of others, or acts of God. Note that this warranty specifically excludes, among other things, rips or tears along seams and bleaching, since these are caused by improper installation, and improper addition of chemicals. Your liner must therefore be installed according to the directions and properly maintained.
- This warranty is null and void if alterations are made to the pool design or if accessories that can cause damage to the liner are used.
- 7. This warranty refers to the original purchaser only and is not transferable. This warranty is intended to be in lieu of any and all warrantees expressed or implied. This warranty is a complete statement of Pegasus Products' obligation. No agent or dealer or other individual is authorized to change this warranty and any such change will not be recognized by Pegasus.
- The ecclosed warranty registration card must be returned to Pegasus within 10 days after purchase.
